



The World in Your Hands Art Contest Rules

This contest is open to all those between the ages of 13-24 who identify as female. Only entries submitted with a complete entry form will be judged. Participants can enter more than once, but a separate entry form must be completed for each work of art. A panel of judges selected by the Coalition for Adolescent Girls will select the winners based on adherence to the theme, creativity of the art work, and creativity of the proposed solution.

Each participant retains the copyright and ownership to her submission, but explicitly grants Together for Girls and the Coalition for Adolescent Girls an irrevocable, nonexclusive license for advertising, marketing, and promotional purposes, in any and all media now known or hereafter created, at Together for Girls or the Coalition for Adolescent Girls' discretion, without additional consideration, notification, permission to participant or any third party. Participants also agree to be bound by these contest rules; and that the decisions of the judges are final on all matters relating to the contest. Participants in the contest are not entitled to any compensation for the use of their work, nor are Together for Girls or the Coalition for Adolescent Girls responsible for any consequences of showcasing the work.

By participating, participants agree to release, discharge and hold harmless Together for Girls and the Coalition for Adolescent Girls and their employees, officers, directors, and representatives from any claims, losses, and damages arising out of their participation in this contest or any contest-related activities and the acceptance and use, misuse, or possession of any prize awarded hereunder.
